The foundation of unity. We see the foundation of unity in Ps 133. Brothers live together here. We are the sons and daughters of the same Father. This relation is not based on the fact that they believe in the same principles or they gather in the same church. God reveals the seven foundation stones of unity in Eph 4:4-6.

One hope: - The fact that we are moving to the same direction with a same goal itself makes us united. In the Holy Communion we see the phrase "Until the Lord comes" which gives us the same hope.

One body: - All believers who are born again have come to the blessed relation that they are the members of the same body. We see this truth in

Eph 1:23 in relation with the universal church of Christ. The glory of this phrase is revealed in 1 Cor 12:27 with regard to the local church. "Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it". The members of the local church should act just as they are the members of the same body. We testify this truth in silence when we eat the Lord's Supper on Lord's Day. There is no wonder that our body works in unity. But the devil has destroyed these basic truths from our mindset that the local church can act in this way. Often we do not consider it as serious when the local church is losing its unity. We say all these things are happening from the first century onwards. We are not taking any immediate

measures when the body of Christ (the church) loses its unity. We have the strong foundation of brotherhood and unity which can guide us just as we are the members of the same body.

One spirit: - All children of God are born again by the power of the same Spirit. So all of us should be controlled by the Holy Spirit (Phi 1:27). We should keep the unity through the Lord of peace (Eph 4:3). The first thing that we see in the fruit of Spirit is love. Only those who live in the fullness of Spirit can keep this unity in the Lord of peace.

One Lord: - All believers accept the Lordship of our Lord (Rom 10:9, 10). Those who are under the same authority can testify God in unity in all the way possible.

God's Greatness Revealed Through Science

One of the reasons for Jesus' primacy over creation is that in Him all things hold together. Not only did Jesus create the universe, He also sustains it. He maintains the delicate balance necessary to life's existence. He quite literally holds all things together. He is the power behind every consistency in the universe. He is gravity and centrifugal and centripetal force. He is the One who keeps all the entities in space in their motion. He is the energy of the universe. In his book *The Atom Speaks*, D Lee Chesnut

describes the puzzle of why the nucleus of an atom holds together.

Consider the dilemma of the nuclear physicist when he finally looks in utter amazement at the pattern he had now drawn of the oxygen nucleus. For here are eight positively charged protons closely associated together within the confines of this tiny nucleus. With them are eight neutrons - a total of sixteen particles - eight positively charged and eight with no charge.

Earlier physicists had discovered that like charges of electricity and

like magnetic poles repel each other and unlike charges or magnetic poles attract each other. And the entire history of electrical phenomena and electrical equipment had been built up on these principles known as Coulomb's law of electrostatic force and the law of magnetism. What was wrong? What holds the nucleus together? Why doesn't it fly apart? And therefore why do not all atoms fly apart?

Chesnut goes on to describe the experiments performed in the 1920 and 1930 that proved

Coulombs law applied to atomic nuclei. Powerful atom smashers were used to fire protons in to the nuclei of atoms. Those experiments also gave scientists an understanding of the incredibly powerful force that held protons together within the nucleus. Scientists have dubbed that force the strong nuclear force but have no explanation for why it exists. The physicist George Gamow one of the founders of the Big Bang theory of the origin of the universe wrote "The fact that we live in a world in which practically every object is a potential nuclear explosive without being blown to bits is due to the extreme difficulties that attend the starting of nuclear reaction. Karl K Darrow a physicist at the bell Laboratories agrees: You grasp what this implies. It implies that all the massive nuclei have no right to be alive at all. Indeed they should never have been created and if created they should have blown up instantly. Yet here they all are Some inflexible inhibition is holding them relentlessly together. The nature of the inhibition is also a secret one thus far reserved by nature for herself.

One day in the future God will dissolve the strong nuclear force. Peter describes that day as the one when the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat and the earth and its works will be burned up (2Peter 3:10). With the strong nuclear force no longer operative Coulombs law will take effect and the nuclei of atoms will fly apart. The universe will literally explode. Until that time we can be thankful that Christ upholds all things by the word of His power Hebrews 1:3. Jesus Christ must be God. He made the universe, existed outside and before it, and preserves it.

God calls every Christian to a life of discipline. There must be discipline in prayer, discipline in studying the Word, discipline in the use of time, discipline in witnessing to others, discipline in sacrificial living. By the example of the Lord Jesus, by the clamant needs of a perishing world and by the personal peril of being a castaway at last, let us discipline ourselves so that Christ will get the most and the best out of these passing lives of ours.

Spiritual Ministry

church. There is no doubt for it. They are the reason for the downward fall of the churches. New souls are not added to the assemblies. Those who are in assembly failed to gain spiritual growth. They are prevented of it. Spiritual and godly men should be the leaders of the assembly. The sole qualifications of many is that they are the husband of one wife. That type of leadership will be a failure. Many of the elders are elders because of their old age. They have no proper knowledge in the word and have no talent to teach the Word also. They though not eligible fight for their positions. They play all sorts of tricks to be on the helm. Many of our assemblies are ruled by such men. They fail to open their mouths to say a word of thanks or few words on any given occasions. Most of them at the same time beat even politicians, if they have to speak on other issues. Discipline

In the Christian life, it is possible to follow the path of least resistance and to escape the rigorous demands of personal discipline. By catering to the soft and flabby desires of the flesh, we can avoid the pain of weariness, hunger and discomfort. But in striving so hard to baby the self-life, we become sterile, barren and insipid.

The flesh struggles unceasingly for V.I.P. treatment. It wants to be surfeited with food, satisfied with sleep, surrounded with pleasure, and sated with attention. Lentil we learn to say NO' and mean it, there can be little progress for God. We must buffet our body and bring it into subjection. We must crucify the flesh with its darling affections and lusts. We must make it our business to rise early, redeem the time, and refuse the pathway of self-indulgence.

By its shocking lack of discipline, Christendom has become a powerless giant. It enjoys the contempt of the world. The disciplined lives of unbelievers often put the Christian in a very bad light.

When asked the secret of his prowess as a pianist, Paderewski said, "Practicing scale, hour after hour, day after day, till these poor fingers were nearly worn to the bone." It is said that Milton used to rise at four every morning to write Paradise Lost. Noah Webster worked for 36 years before the first edition of his dictionary was finished. Men are willing to endure tremendous hardship for earthly honors. Sir Ernest Shackleton once placed this ad in a London paper: Men wanted for hazardous journey. Small wages, bitter cold, long months of complete darkness, constant danger, safe return doubtful. Honor and recognition in case of success. They all returned to their homes in safety, and were given honor and recognition. They did it to obtain crown: how much more should we be willing to do for an incorruptible crown.

Many would like to enjoy the reward of a job, well done, but they don't want the toil, heartache and loneliness that often lead to it. For Gibbon it meant 26 long years of discipline to write the Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire. For Bryant it meant rewriting Thanatopsis 99 times.

Jowett said, "Vast ambitions are not kept burning

in the soul without fuel. They suck the very energies of the body into their own flame. Fine passion makes a heavy drain upon the nerves; the suburbs are scoured to feed the fire at the center. There is not a man or woman of holy Christian passion today who is not burning the candle at both ends." Audubon, the great naturalist, was willing to undergo prolonged discomfort to learn more of the world of birds. Let Robert G. Lee tell it: He counted his physical comforts as "nothing" compared with success in his work. He would rise at midnight and go out into the swamps to study the habits of certain night hawks. He would crouch motionless for 0 hours in the dark and fog, feeling himself well rewarded, if, after weeks of waiting he secured one additional fact about a single bird. During one summer he went day after day to the near New Orleans to observe a shy waterfowl.
